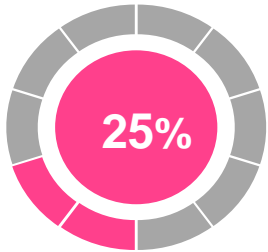




4 in 5 STEM college students said they decided their field of study in high school or earlier
